Maths

- We will count money in pence and pounds.
- We will pick notes and coins to make the same amount in different ways.
- We will compare amounts and calculate with money.
- We will find change from £1 and complete money word problems.
- We will recognise, make and add equal groups.
- We will recognise the multiplication symbol and use arrays.
- We make equal groups by grouping and sharing.
- We will learn our 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
- We will learn to divided by 2, 5 and 10
- We will double and halve and recognise odd and evens,
- We will measure in standard metric units
- We compare length, height, volume, capacity and temperature.

Music and Art & Design

- We will explore Pitch through songs and percussion.
- We will learn songs about animals and the Rainforest.
- We will study the work of Henri Rousseau in Art and create our own pictures in his style.
- We will use a range of materials creatively to design and make products linked to Bird Week.

Geography and History

- We will learn about the features of the rainforest and the life and people within it.
- We will study a contrasting locality to our own comparing similarities and differences (Brazil and the Amazon Rainforest).
- We will learn about significant historical figures: Ada Lovelace and Alun Turing.

We will read a variety of Julia Donaldson books and a wide range of fiction and non fiction books to enhance our Rainforest learning and History studies.

- We will find the features of information texts in our reading.
- We will have a daily phonics lesson.
- We will practice our handwriting daily and use our joined writing skills with more consistency.
- We will continue with Big Write, producing fact and fiction pieces in different genres
- We will create poems based on the rainforest theme.
- We will extend our use of different punctuation.
- We will recognise past and present tense.
- We will recognise types of sentence, i.e. statement, command, question, exclamation.
- We will learn about the features of a sentence, i.e. noun, verb, adjective, adverb.
